## COSMOS Tour 2009 WHITEHORSE, YUKON

### COSMOS Tour 2009:

- We will be travelling "On Tour" to Whitehorse, Yukon along with the U12/U13 girls team. We have arranged for several matches against Whitehorse teams over multiple days. "Tour" is also about having fun and will include camping, pool time, hot springs, touring Whitehorse, etc. Families are invited to camp out with the team in the campground and participate in activities.
- We will travel to Skagway via AMHS ferry and go from Skagway to Whitehorse via bus. Lodging will be in the Takhini Campgrounds. Tents are the anticipated lodging method, but anyone who wants to bring a camper can do so. Please let us know. We can get you a big discount too. **PASSPORTS FOR ALL TRAVELLERS ARE MANDATORY**
- Travel:
  - Thursday 23 JUL- Depart Juneau Ferry Terminal. Ferry leaves at 1:15am which means that we are supposed to check in as a group at 11:45pm on **WED** night. This gets us to Skagway at 8:15am. We'll bus to Whitehorse and be in town around the middle of the day. We'll set up camp.
  - FRI, SAT, SUN – Matches, touring, fun, etc. We are still working on the details but it looks like we'll be having a match followed by a party with the Whitehorse boys on SAT.
  - Monday 27 JUL- Depart Whitehorse at a comfortable time in the morning. (around 9am) and bus to Skagway. We'll have fun in Skagway and catch the 5:15pm ferry to Juneau. Ferry gets into Juneau at 12:45am (technically Tuesday).
- As a youth group we should be able to get the 50% discount. Calls are in with AMHS and we'll get the specifics. We are camping out. The plan is to have the boys in tents that have at least 2. 4-person tents are optimal but 2-person tents will work. Start thinking about borrowing a tent if you don't have one. If you cannot find one, we may be able to get a loaner.
- Food will be done centrally for the camp and we'll need volunteers for Camp Cook positions (share the pain). We could use a volunteer to help pick out the menus.
- Expenses are being added up and we'll have a good estimate by next week on a per player basis. Total cost should be less than \$300 without any problem but let's see what the budget works out to be.
- We will do Tour planning on Saturday, 18 JUL at the Camp Conclusion Party. We hope to have most of the details ironed out before then.
- We need commitments early so that we know how many to make reservations for etc. Please fill out the attached form as soon as you can. We really need them by Sunday 12 JUL.
